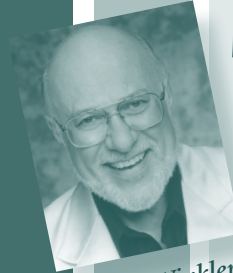

Ron Surace's "In Full Swing" Jazz Orchestra

Dr. Ron Surace studied with the great George Shearing, and was a winner of the "Silver Award" and the "Outstanding Musical Performance Award," at Downbeat magazine's Musicfest USA National Finals. Surace's jazz recordings have been released on the Columbia Pictures and Southport Recording labels to great critical acclaim. The Jazz Review/ New York wrote: "*Chicago pianist and composer Surace...if he were based in NY, LA or Paris he'd be known the world 'round.*"

Surace has performed with Bill Watrous, Dick Oates (Thad Jones/Mel Lewis jazz orchestra), Cleve Eaton (Count Basie jazz orchestra), Willie Smith, and John Faddis. As a big band pianist, he has played with the Glen Miller, Bob Crosby, and Ralph Martieri big bands and has presented music for the Bob Hope and Steve Allen road show productions.

Surace's "In Full Swing" jazz orchestra performs regularly for television, community centers, fundraisers, and schools/universities. Their mission is to create authentic classic big band works in both style and form, presenting masterpieces of big band jazz music from 1920 to the present.

Frank Winkler Quartet

Veteran Chicago pianist and conductor Frank Winkler has led a wide array of ensembles from jazz to classical. He has performed with legendary stars Frank Sinatra, Sammy Davis, Jr., Liza Minelli, and Buddy Rich. Winkler's performance credits also include the Chicago Symphony Orchestra, Royal English Ballet, Bolshoi Ballet, and the Ravinia Festival

Orchestra. As a conductor, Winkler has led the Harper Symphony Orchestra, the Symphonic Pops Orchestra of Chicago, and many other ensembles.

The Frank Winkler Quartet, featuring virtuoso guitarist Frank Portolese, is one of the most exciting jazz quartets to ever appear in the Midwest. Nick Tountas on bass and Highland Park's own Rick Shandling on drums round out this stunning ensemble, which is as cohesive and thrilling as a top-flight string quartet. The ensemble's arrangements include roaring big-band hits, soulful ballads and effervescent bossa-novas.

Karl E. H. Seigfried

Composer and bassist Karl E. H. Seigfried brings his critically-acclaimed trio to Highland Park for this special concert of original jazz. Seigfried's music combines swing, blues, soul, and New Orleans street music to create jazz that is both memorable and danceable. He has performed jazz bass on stage and on recordings with artists as diverse as Bobby McFerrin and Motörhead. Lauded by Reverend Al Sharpton as one of the "*innovative jazz musicians who have come to public attention since the early 1990s,*" Seigfried has appeared as a character in British comic books, is a recognized writer on boxing, and is an in-demand speaker on topics including jazz history and Norse mythology.
